

INVITATION TO JOIN THE ANNUAL PRO LIFE MARCH THROUGH AMSTERDAM

Pro Life March from Dam Square, December 12, 2009 gathering at 14:00 hrs.

On December 12, 2009 we will gather at 14:00 hrs. on the DAM SQUARE in Amsterdam, the Netherlands with the seventeenth Pro Life March to focus the attention upon 600.000 women, who had an abortion since the legalisation of abortion and for all the children who lost their lives in an abortion clinic. The March will be closed with a service at the Keizersgracht Church.

Service for 'Pro Life' in the Keizersgrachtchurch'(nr. 566) on December 12th at 15:30 hrs.

At a prayer and action service at the 'Keizersgrachtchurch' the March will be closed. Speakers will be: drs. H. van Rhee, director of "Vereniging tot Heil des Volks" (Society for the blessing of the People – a society for the prevention of drugs etc.), Feike te Velde, evangelist and editor of 'Zoeklicht' (an evangelical magazine) and mr. A. Baan, director of a Reformed Youth Movement – 'Heartcry'. Dr. and Mrs. Dorenbos will also this year present awards to those who have done special services for the Pro Life Movement.

Night Watches on December 18th at the Abortion Clinics in The Netherlands

On December 18th 1980 the 'Law for the Ending of a Pregnancy' was accepted by the Dutch Parliament with a majority of only one vote. Therefore a silent watch with burning torches and prayer for the abolition of abortion is held every year on December 18th in front of the abortion clinics. These watches start at 18:00 hrs. 600.000 women had an abortion and at least as many children lost their lives in the abortion clinics.

Since the 'Law for the Ending of a Pregnancy' was accepted at the beginning of the eighties at least half a million women lost their child through abortion. More than half a million children have been aborted. Also half a million men are fathers from a dead child. Aborted. Mothers, who come home with an echo, know that they see a baby. At conception all hereditary qualities are already present. It is even possible to treat malfunctions during a pregnancy. Abortionist now often say that they practice 'abortion-help' to prevent the birth of 'unwanted children'.

However our Constitution and the Declaration of Human Rights forbids the discrimination of a man and certainly of a child and they may not be killed at all. Therefore the 'Law for the Ending of a Pregnancy' should be changed into a 'Law for Helping in a Pregnancy' to help fathers and mothers with the problems of an unwanted pregnancy.

It becomes more and more known that women and man who have had an abortion will have problems sooner or later with the loss of their child. Women will get serious psychological problems. At present the government is doing a research to look into these post - abortion problems. And it will also be looked into what precisely the problems are of women who decides to have an abortion. There is also a consensus that when someone considers an abortion that he then should know all the facts and the consequences of an abortion. And that through honest information the public opinion could be changed. From questionnaires held at the "Huishoudbeurs" it became clear that the majority of the people doesn't know what takes place at an abortion. But when a model is shown of an unborn child of ten weeks old many come to realize that at abortion a real fellow unborn human being is killed. 'Cry for Life' calls on everyone to come to the March that is held every year and also asks everyone to go to work with the models and the folders in their own surroundings.

The government should not be focussed on raising the age for receiving an 'Old Age Pension' but on a positive view to child support. Because due to abortions and an unfriendly attitude towards children and the family we will end up with a society in which an ever smaller group will have to take care of the costs of a growing group of senior citizens.
