for the General Assembly of One of US Federation for Life and Human Dignity
on Friday September 18th, From 10:00 to 16:00
in Brussels, Belgium (European Parliament/To Be Confirmed)

A more detailed invitation will come, notably when the availability of **Financial Sponsorship for Travel and Lodging Costs** is confirmed by our sponsor.

Your presence is highly important, because we will present and discuss the following updates and strategies together:

- ✓ the **One of Us initiative lawsuit** at the European Court of Justice and upcoming audience in the Fall during which pro abortion lobbies IPPF and Marie Stopes International will likely intervene (the Court has not accepted to date)
- ✓ the **launch in September of the Europe-wide Appeal to health, legal and political Experts** to protect life and ask the EU leadership to bring the One of Us initiative back to the table of Parliament.
- ✓ the **preparation of the One of Us European Forum on Jan. 22-23 in Paris** (not anymore on Dec. 12) to raise awareness of a large public and media - including the Ceremony of the first One of Us Award for Life and Human Dignity

SPECIAL NOTE: On September 18th, in addition to our discussion, each Member Entity of the Federation will be invited to vote to **elect the Winner of the One of Us European Award!** The vote will happen on the basis of One Person (for each Member Entity) = 1 vote.

All entities representatives and friends are welcome to arrive the day before, on Thursday Sept. 17th for an opening dinner together at 19:30.

This is a “pro-life friends-only” event, but all allies and former support of the One of us initiative are most welcome to join, so spread the word.
